Hazur Mahraz Darshan Das, founder/patron of Sachkhand Nanak Dham International and a religious leader of a very large multicultural community abroad and in India, has been shot and killed by two gunmen who opened fire at the congregational gathering consisting of women, children and men held at Dormers Wells High School, Dormers Wells Lane, Southall, Middlesex. Mahraz Darshan Das, after delivering the Holy Message, mingled in the congregation of about 200 people to talk to them. The shooting happened at 9.50 p.m.

Hazur Mahraz Darshan Das, whose Mission Sachkhand Nanak Dham always professed His Divine Message of service to mankind and laid stress on the message of Love, Peace, Unity and Sacrifice, which are the inherent needs and ideals of all humanity. From amongst the congregation three other people were also wounded by gun shots and are recovering in hospital.

Mahraz Jee was neither the leader of a Sikh splinter group, nor proclaimed to have a breakaway group of his own. He never ever provoked any trouble, but always preached love, unity and brotherhood amongst mankind. He always preached, practiced and even breathed the breath of humanity. Nothing else mattered to Him but the betterment and good of everyone.
